


Configuring your email client: Windows Live Mail

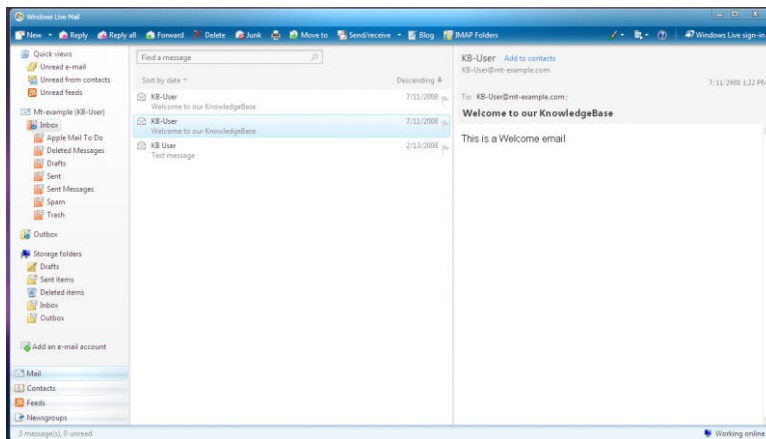
5. You will now get a message that your folders are downloading:
